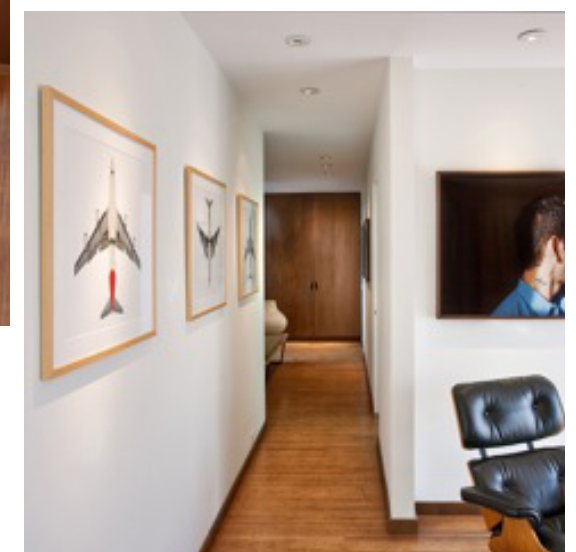
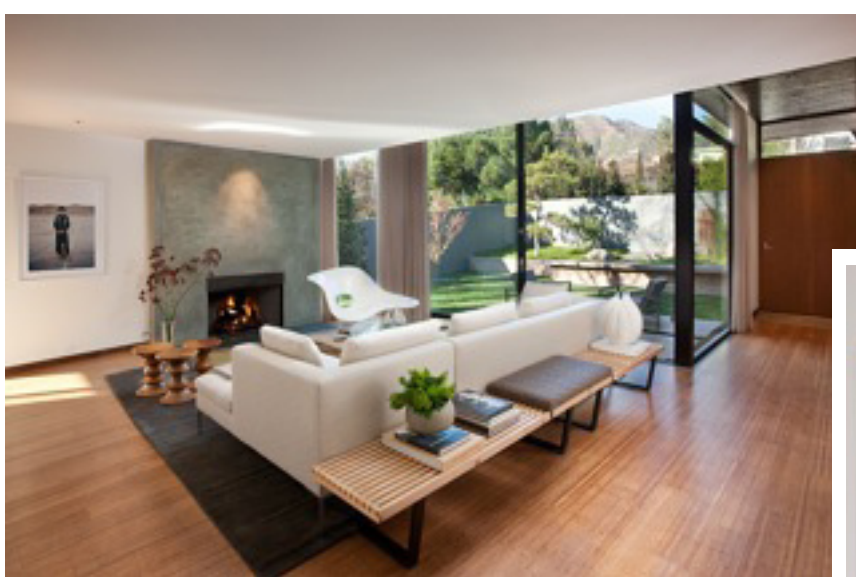

This renovation took a small house, preserved its modest sensibility, made it feel more expansive, and gave it a sleek, modern, sophisticated style.

The house blurs the lines between indoors and outdoors with a new entry, raised ceilings, and floor-to-ceiling living room windows that frame stunning mountain vistas.

The home also features a study that opens onto a generous rear terrace, a master bedroom slider that frames a specimen maple, and an exterior master bathroom door that leads directly into the shower—perfect for rinsing sand off after a trip to the beach.
