

Project Highlights

2,061 SF MODERN COTTAGE 750 SF PRIMARY SUITE ADDITION



This project started as a whole home remodel for this 2,061 square foot modern cottage residence built in 1965, and grew to include a complete primary suite addition. Highlights of the remodel include opening up the entrance to create a larger living and dining room and showcase the view opposite the front door, reconfiguring the kitchen for better flow, dividing a shared bath into two separate en suite bathrooms, and relocating and adding windows to let in more light.

Later, the homeowner decided to relocate the primary suite to the opposite side of the home with a 750 square foot addition that included a new primary bedroom, bathroom, and closet.



The home was designed to showcase the homeowners colorful and unique art collection that is placed throughout the home. The most unique piece of art is the wallpaper in the primary suite that was hand-painted and carefully designed to flow around the doors and windows in the space.
